
Building an AB Courtyard Wall Panel


Step 1: Determine location and dig a level trench 3 in. deep (75 mm) and 7 in. wide (180 mm). Lay in 3 in. (75 mm) of crushed rock and compact.\*





**Step 2:** Install the base course of block on the crushed rock, tamping and leveling into place. The raised rings on the top of the blocks lock courses toaether.

# **Ordering Materials Walls**

Determine the height of your wall in courses - each course is 6 in. (150 mm) high. Measure the total length of the wall or walls, and use the chart at right or use our Estimating Tool at allanblock.com to find the number of blocks you will need. The AB Courtyard Collection is not to be used as a retaining wall.




Some of the AB Dublin and AB York blocks have splitting notches to help with building your wall.



### **Patterns**

Use any combination of the AB Dublin and AB York blocks and create your own random pattern. Use our Estimating Tool located at allanblock.com to determine your block quantities when building patterns.

## Step Downs / Ending Walls

Walls can be "stepped down" in two ways. *See How-To sheet #160 for more information.* 

Use corner blocks to end each course

or

try adding an extra wall cap at the end of each course.


Note: Order extra caps or corners for each step down.

# **Posts**

For posts you will need 4 corner blocks per course. Each post will require 2 post caps.


